The **EIBA Early Career Network (EIBA-ECN)** was launched at the EIBA 2014 conference in Uppsala with the goal to establish a forum for cooperation among EIBA's early-career researchers. EIBA-ECN scholars are brought together to share ideas, build up networks with like-minded individuals, and discuss research projects with a view to the possibilities of cooperation and collaboration.

So far, the annual EIBA Early Career Network Paper Development Workshop (EIBA-ECN-PDW) was attended by over 90 early-career researchers. The works developed and discussed during the EIBA-ECN-PDW evolved into publications at journals such as *Academy of Management Discoveries*, *International Business Review*, and *Organization Science*, among others.
