

JIBS Paper Development Workshop

Submission deadline: 12 September 2025

A Journal of Interna-onal Business Studies Paper Development Workshop (JIBS-PDW) will be held on Thursday 11 December 2025, as a pre-conference ac4vity of the 51st European Interna4onal Business Academy (EIBA) conference, to be held at the University of Piraeus, Athens.

The purpose of the JIBS-PDW is to provide scholars with developmental feedback on their current research projects in Interna4 onal Business. Authors will be paired with senior Interna4 onal Business scholars for construc4ve discussions about their papers.

The JIBS-PDW is being organized by Ana Botella Andreu (University of Valencia) and Catherine Welch (Trinity College Dublin), in collabora4 on with Guus Hendricks (Amsterdam Business School), Bersant Hobdari (Copenhagen Business School) and Emine Beyza Satoglu (Bogazici University) from the AIB Western Europe Chapter.

We invite original papers from doctoral students or faculty members who have not previously published in *JIBS*. We par4cularly encourage papers from scholars (1) who are located in universi4es in emerging economies or in universi4es that offer limited support for interna4onal business research, or (2) who are trained in disciplines less commonly associated with the field (e.g., human geography, poli4cal science, or economic history) but interested in conduc4ng interna4onal business research. While we hope that many of these papers will eventually be submiVed to *JIBS*, the aim of the PDW more generally is to heighten the quality of IB research, and bring new scholars into the IB field.

The deadline for submissions is **12 September 2025**. Each applicant can submit only <u>one</u> research paper to the PDW, but you may submit the same paper for presenta4on at the EIBA 2025 Conference. (Please note that the deadline for submiXng EIBA conference papers and panel proposals has passed.) Papers for the JIBS-PDW must be less than 10,000 words in



length. We request that you do not submit a paper that is currently under review at JIBS.

To apply to the JIBS-PDW, you should submit your research paper to: Ana.botella@uv.es. Your cover page should include all the author names, emails and affilia4ons.

You will be no4fied about the acceptance of your submission by 1 October, and you will need to confirm par4cipa4on by 15 October, which is the early-bird registra4on deadline for the conference. All par4cipants must register for the EIBA 2025 conference before they confirm their aVendance at the JIBS-PDW.
